

Annual Programme

The programme of excavations, lectures, and excursions runs throughout the year.

EXCAVATIONS: Members participate in field-walking, geo-physical surveys, site planning, excavating, finds processing, etc. This year the Field Unit has been working at Hog Croft Field, Ovingdean. Next year's site has yet to be decided. Join the "diggers" for active archaeological research: training is given!

LECTURES: During the winter, illustrated lectures are given by specialists on a wide range of archaeological and historical subjects, with particular interest on local and regional topics. Lectures are held centrally in Brighton.

EXCURSIONS: Coach excursions take place during Summer months.

LOCAL HISTORY FORUM: Holds seminars and arranges walkabouts, on topics of local interest.

PUBLICATIONS: The Society's newsletter "FLINT" appears half-yearly, with Reports and Accounts published annually.

EMAIL UPDATES: Twice weekly updates on Sundays and Thursdays are sent out by email; reporting on the week's activities and what is coming up in the near future. This includes what is planned by BHAS and other local archaeological/historical groups and includes any relevant courses, conferences and day schools.

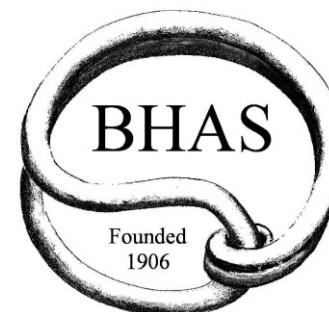
