The Society has a wide range of activities for members throughout the year.

Annual Subscription: Adult £20 or Full time Student £10

What membership offers you:-

FIELD WORK: Members participate in field-walking, geo-physical surveys, site planning, excavating, finds processing, etc. Join the "diggers" for active archaeological research, training is given.

LECTURES: During the winter, illustrated lectures are given by specialists on a wide range of archaeological and historical subjects, with particular focus on local and regional topics. Archaeology lectures in central Brighton.

LOCAL HISTORY FORUM: Holds monthly talks in winter on topics of local interest, also seminars, and summer walkabouts. Local History lectures in central Hove.

DAY SCHOOLS: Tuition from experts on archaeological skills, techniques, and interpreting the past, 2 or 3 times a year. (Additional fees apply.)

EXCURSIONS: Walks and excursions take place during Summer.

PUBLICATIONS: The Society's newsletter "**FLINT**" appears half-yearly, with Reports and Accounts published annually.

EMAIL UPDATES: Weekly updates are sent out by email. Everything you need to know about what's on in the Society plus information about archaeology-related events locally.
